The objective of the watercraft inspection station is to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species such as quagga & zebra mussels as well as aquatic weeds.

Training will be provided in person both prior to inspecting as well as throughout the season. Station hours are from dawn to dusk April 12<sup>th</sup>- September 30<sup>th</sup>. Shifts range between 6-8 hours varying with daylight hours throughout the season.
